

Reddam House/NCUK Partnership: Fact Sheet

- Reddam House is the first educational institution in South Africa to offer the International Foundation Year (IFY) through a partnership with the Northern Consortium of UK Universities (NCUK)
- NCUK have been running the IFY course since 1987 and the qualification has been available in Africa for the past 16 years through our sister school in Kenya and other schools in Nigeria and Algeria
- Reddam House is part of Inspired Education a leading global premium schools group educating over 45 000 students across an international network of over 64 schools on five continents
- From January 2021, Reddam House will be offering the IFY bridging course at two of its campuses: Constantia (Cape Town) and Waterfall (Gauteng) – This course is available to all students even if you have not completed your matric at Reddam House or Reddford House
- The IFY is run as an 'in classroom' course over a seven-month (January to July) period
- The IFY is a post-matric qualification designed to prepare students for first year entry to undergraduate degree courses and the outcome is comparable with A-level
- The IFY course is open to all matriculants who have a university exemption matric certificate Bachelor's degree pass
- All curricula, examinations, coursework, and moderation are provided externally by
- Over 40 000 international students have been through the IFY course, of these 1 300 have been from Africa
- NCUK offers guaranteed entry into 32 universities based in the UK, Australia, New Zealand, Canada and the USA. Seven are ranked in the latest QS Word Top 100 Universities (Manchester, Bristol, Auckland, Western Australia, Birmingham, Leeds, Sheffield)
- NCUK recruit students from over 100 nationalities annually, 90% get into their first choice university. 80% of NCUK students achieve a first or second class degree at university
- As with A Levels, students choose three academic modules, depending on which
 degree they want to study at university. English for Academic Purposes for Proficient
 Users is part of the IFY course
- The following IFY Pathways are possibilities: Business, Science and Engineering, Medicine and Humanities
 There are over 4 000 degrees available across a wide range of faculties and universities
- If a student achieves a 'C' grade (96 points) in each of their academic modules (three) plus a 'C' grade in EAPPU they are guaranteed a place at an NCUK University
- NCUK assists students with their university applications, obtaining their study visas and applying for a scholarship, if required. Full guidance and support is provided by the NCUK's Student Support Team
